MINUTES

President, Deb Griewank, called the Marshall County Plan Commission meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, December 17, 2009, in Room 203 of the Marshall County Building. Present were: Commission Members, Tom Chamberlin, Stan Klotz, Larry Fisher, Don Morrison, Bob Yoder, David Dinius, Ron McCartney and Deb Griewank. Plan Director Ralph Booker, Secretary Lorna Shively, and interested parties were present. Mr. Davis was absent.

The first item of business was the review of the minutes from the September 24, 2009, meeting. **Mr. Morrison moved and Mr. Dinius seconded the motion to approve the minutes. The motion passed by acclamation.**

The second item of business was reviewing the 2010 Plan Commission Meeting Dates. **Mr. Morrison moved and Mr. Fisher seconded the motion to accept the 2010 meeting dates. The motion passed by acclamation.**

Mr. Booker initiated discussion with the Commission on residential parking requirements for residences. This matter will be included for a public hearing next month to define the required number of spaces.

The next item discussed was the definition of a shooting range. After some discussion, the Commission directed Mr. Booker to run a public notice to define a shooting range.

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The next item of business was the Authority Clause in Telecommunications Facilities. The language will need to be revised, however, this matter was tabled to a later date pending the findings of the Court.

Mr. Booker began reviewing the 2007 Subdivision Ordinance. Chapters 1-3 were reviewed. By consensus of the Commission, policy reviews will take place during scheduled meetings when there are no cases to hear. Two chapters will be reviewed at a time.

There being no other business before the Plan Commission, a motion was presented and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed by acclamation and the meeting was adjourned.
