

NOT FOR PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

In accordance with state laws, civic, fraternal, social, religious, etc. Organizations which qualify for tax exempt status, and operate less than fifteen (15) days in a calendar year, are also exempt from compliance with Public Health Laws.

Tax exempt status does not exempt an organization from liability or reduce its risk of initiation a food borne outbreak. In order to hasten the process should a food outbreak investigation occur, the Marshall County Health Department requires a non-profit information sheet to be filled out and returned to the Health Department prior to the event.
